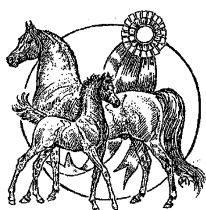

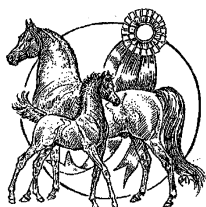

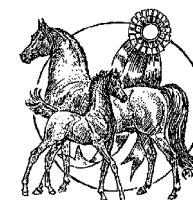
ELECTRICAL HOOK-UPS ARE AVAILABLE BY DIRECT ARRANGEMENT WITH THE  
SHOWGROUND, AT A COST OF £30 FOR THE WEEKEND. A £25 DEPOSIT FOR THE ACCESS KEY  
WILL BE REQUIRED, BUT THIS WILL BE REFUNDED UPON RETURN OF THE ACCESS KEY.

- **Entries close Wednesday 1st September** – Late entries and on the day will not be accepted.
- Classes will be combined if fewer than two entries
- **CURRENT EQUINE 'FLU' VACCINATION CERTIFICATES ARE REQUIRED** for all horses entered and failure to produce on demand could mean expulsion from the college premises
- **HORSE PASSPORTS MUST BE CARRIED**
- Breaks for tack changes must be notified (**This will not be allowed Saturday evening during Championships**)
- Withdrawals must be notified
- Substitutions are permitted
- The Two Minute Gate Rule will be applied
- BS or PAS hats must be worn in all jumping classes and by all youth members. **THE BMHS STRONGLY RECOMMENDS THAT ALL RIDERS WEAR PAS 015 RIDING HATS, CORRECTLY FITTED AND FASTENED. FAILURE TO DO SO MAY INVALIDATE INSURANCE COVER AND IS ENTIRELY AT THE RIDER'S RISK. YOUTH MEMBERS MUST WEAR THE SPECIFIED STANDARD OF HARD HAT AT ALL TIMES WHEN RIDING, DRIVING OR IN HAND**
- Access to stables from 9am Friday 10th September
- All contact regarding the show must be through Trudy Connolly/ Clare Northcott NOT The Hand Equestrian Centre
- All competitors are responsible for their own safety and that of others. Please ensure that you do not undertake any activities which may jeopardise the safety of others or their horses
- Refunds can only be considered upon production of a valid vet's certificate
- There are limited permanent stables but strong temporary stables will be also available. These will be bedded down & extra bedding is available to purchase.
- **A Deposit of £20.00 is payable and will be given back upon inspection of your stable upon departure.**
- There will be a competition for the best decorated stalls. Please do not use staples or pins, use tapes and ties only. Judging will be Saturday lunchtime
- The judge's decision is FINAL
- Please keep dogs under control at all times
- **If you are not a member of the BMHS you must hold third Party liability insurance.**
- If camping in a tent please ensure it is pitched out of the way from vehicles. There is a fee to pay for caravans but campers are free if towing a trailer.
